The National University of Vanuatu (NUV)

The National University of Vanuatu (NUV) was established in January 2020. Its main campus is located in Port Vila and its purpose is to provide higher education advancement and lifelong learning through academic and professional excellence by way of training, teaching and learning in both the English and French official languages, research and international cooperation. On the 15th March 2021, the former Vanuatu Institute of Teacher Education (VITE) was established under NUV as the School of Education (SOE).

As a new school under NUV, the SOE needs a VIBRANT TEAM to build and grow it!

The NUV is seeking expressions of interest from suitably qualified and experienced academics to teach in the following disciplines at its SOE:

- 1. <u>Sciences & Mathematics</u>: Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Earth Science, General Mathematics, Calculus, Statistics
- 2. Arts and Humanities: Languages, Literature, History, Geography
- 3. <u>Education Studies</u>: Psychology, Early Childhood Care and Education, Inclusive Education, School Leadership and Management, Vocational Education and Training

Special Requirements/Instructions:

- The **minimum qualification** for all posts is a Master Degree or equivalent in appropriate areas (e.g., MSc, MA or MEd) with proven experience in teaching and research in similar positions
- Only candidates meeting the minimum qualification criteria are encouraged to apply
- Candidates intending to apply must have at least 3 years' teaching experience. Preference will be given to applicants with a Graduate Certificate in Tertiary Teaching or equivalent and experience in teacher training (specificity in both content and pedagogy)
- There are, in principle, equivalent number of positions using French and English syllabuses, so candidates with teaching and working backgrounds in both languages are encouraged to apply but preference will be given to candidates who are fluent in both English and French (the use of Bislama for non-nationals would be a plus)
- Candidates should be able to do a minimum of 15 to 20 hours of teaching per week corresponding to 3 courses each, and depending on other workload (administrative, research...)
- The positions are open to Vanuatu citizens/residents and external candidates
- Both males and females are encouraged to apply
- Only shortlisted candidates will be contacted
- To apply for the position(s), interested candidates must submit a clear motivation letter with a
 recent CV and names and details of <u>two</u> Referees addressed to the NUV Human Resource
 Manager.
