Reporting To	Director of the Language Centre
Job Purpose	Strengthen English proficiency and apply it to respective training
Position Summary	Teaching English, assessing and evaluating students, supporting students in their academic journey
Key Responsibilities – Detailed Listing	 Provide in-person classroom instruction per contracted dates and times (24 contact hours). Create syllabi, lesson plans, assessment and reflections according to NUV requirements. Follow NUV policies (or NUV partner universities) for student attendance, grading, and assessment. Assess students according to the Program's requirement. Attend meetings for lesson evaluation, planning sessions, and other required faculty meetings. Take part in NUV proctoring and grading language placement test process. Evaluate and communicate student progress throughout the course. Advise students who are struggling or having problems succeeding in class. Cooperate and collaborate with the Program coordinator, Director of Language Center, Bilingual Lecturer, other NUV staff. Comply with and participate to NUV Language Centre's activities and if needed, incorporate them in the course's program.
Critical Competencies	 Good level degree in this subject or another directly related subject or a suitable Post Graduate qualification 3 A-Levels, IB or equivalent. Thorough knowledge of the material covered in the Curriculum of this subject.
Qualifications	 Bachelor's degree or similar certification in a relevant field (English, English literature, English as a Second Language, English as a Foreign Language, Education). Teaching certification is an asset. Good knowledge of the current curriculum in Year 12, 13 is an asset.
Special Skills	Remain current on new developments and trends in the field of ESL, EFL.
Required Experience	 Some experience teaching/tutoring at Year 12, 13 or at university level. Strong English written and oral communication skills and ability to guide students' understanding.
Language	Fluency in English– bilingual in French preferred. Knowledge of Bislama is an advantage.
